The committee has also started to discuss internally a longer list of potential topics around the root zone and root zone distribution. The purpose if this exercise is to committee members' perspectives of topics within or outside the scope of RZERC in a "temperature of the room" sense.

While several committees might address a variety of aspects that touch upon the root zone and the DNS root in general, a topic might also be considered in-scope for none of the committees. One reason might be that an issue is considered "operational" in nature, but the community should follow this closely. Examples that have been discussed within the ccNSO are

o the technical checks performed by the IANA (upon changes to the TLD NS-RRSet) of the technical checks performed by the RZM (same) o crypto algorithm eligibility (for DS records)

The KSK rollover discussion and further developments might also be worth looking into.
