


ccNSO Membership (according to ICANN regions)



- ccNSO Working Groups
 - Permanent (SOP WG) or Temporary (Fol WG)
 - Policy related, informational
 - Scope defined per charter, volunteers from ccTLD community
 - Reporting to ccNSO Council (administratively)
 - Some cross-community (ccNSO-GAC)

- Policy Development Process
 - Very limited in use
 - Predefined in ICANN Bylaws (Annex B process, Annex C scope of issues

- Study Groups
 - Light weight charter, advise to Council
 - Research focused (Study Group country and territory names)
- ccNSO Council Committee
 - Administrative focus
 - Report to Council

- ccNSO Statements and Positions
 - ccNSO Council or ccNSO statement
 - Drafting team (subject expertise and drafting expertise)
 - Council and/or membership adoption of draft
 - Response or input public consultation ICANN or SO/AC


