Standing for ccNSO Council

- Implementation of the reforms arising from the **Accountability** work done during the IANA Stewardship transition.

Background

I first attended an ICANN Meeting in 2006 when InternetNZ hosted the Wellington meeting in New Zealand. I have been a regular attendee and participant since the Buenos Aires meeting in 2013.

I also served as the Secretariat of APTLD from 2004 to 2009, and got to know many in our ccTLD family from the Asia Pacific and beyond during those years.

I've been on the staff of InternetNZ in a variety of roles since 2003, and became Chief Executive in August 2013. Following our structural reforms in 2017, I became Group Chief Executive of InternetNZ and Chair of the Board of Domain Name Commission Ltd in early 2018.
