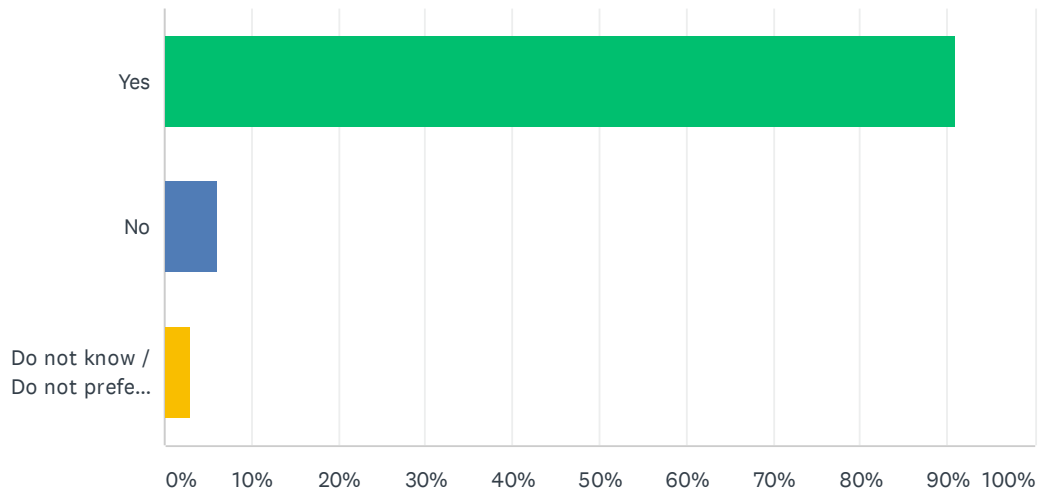

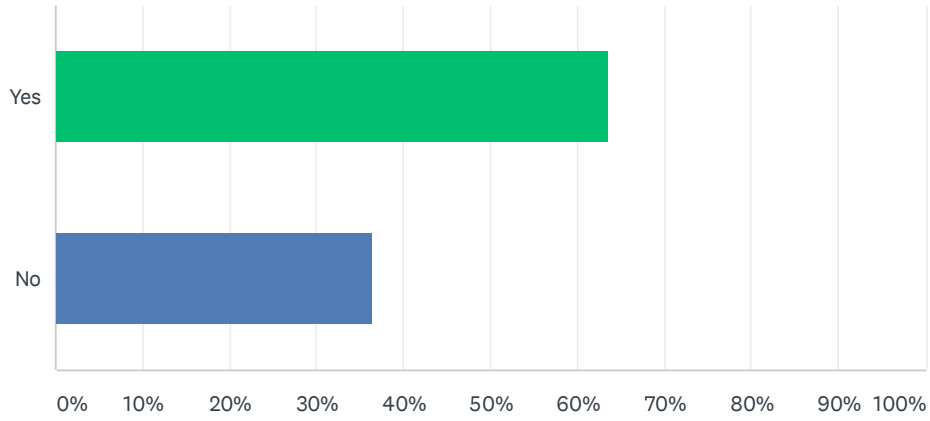

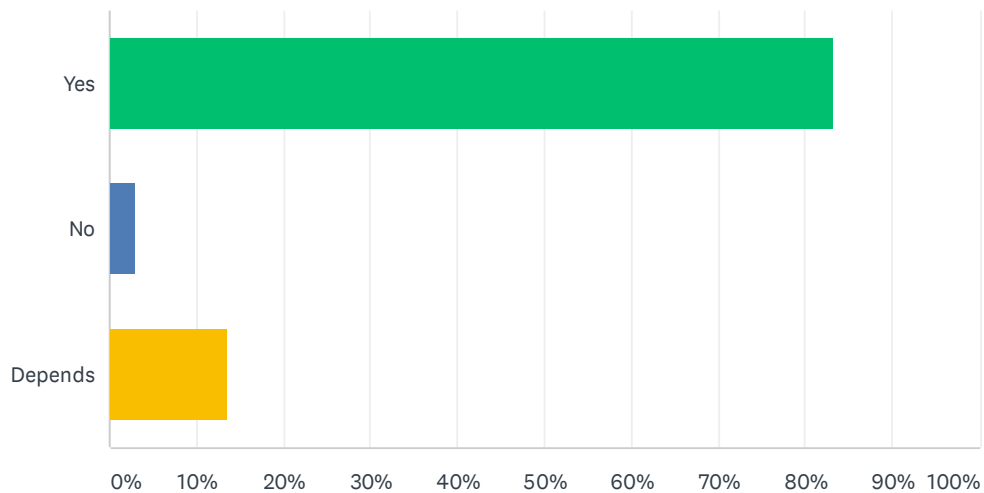

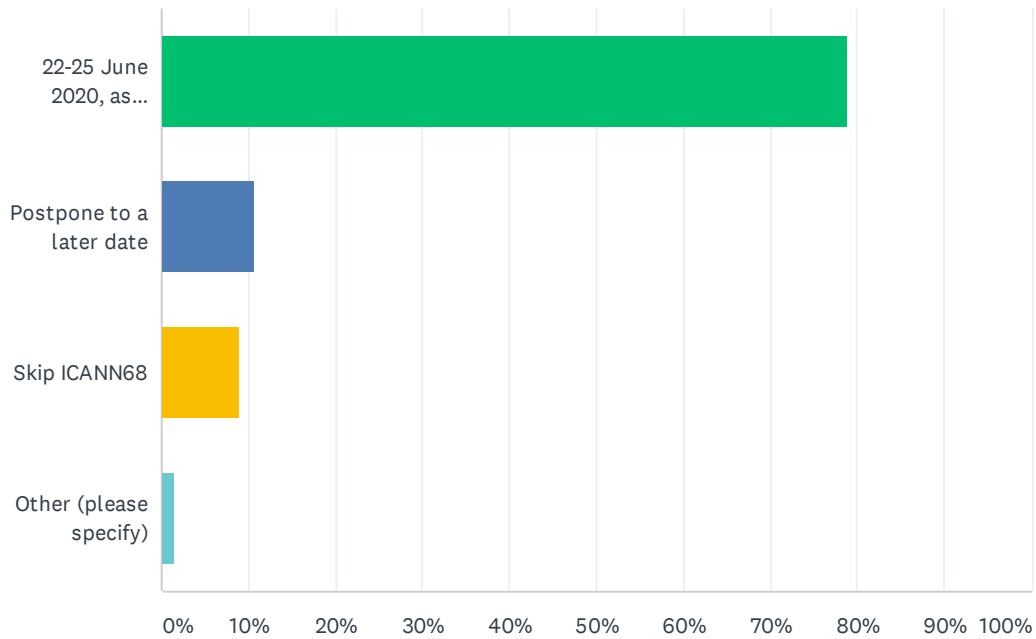

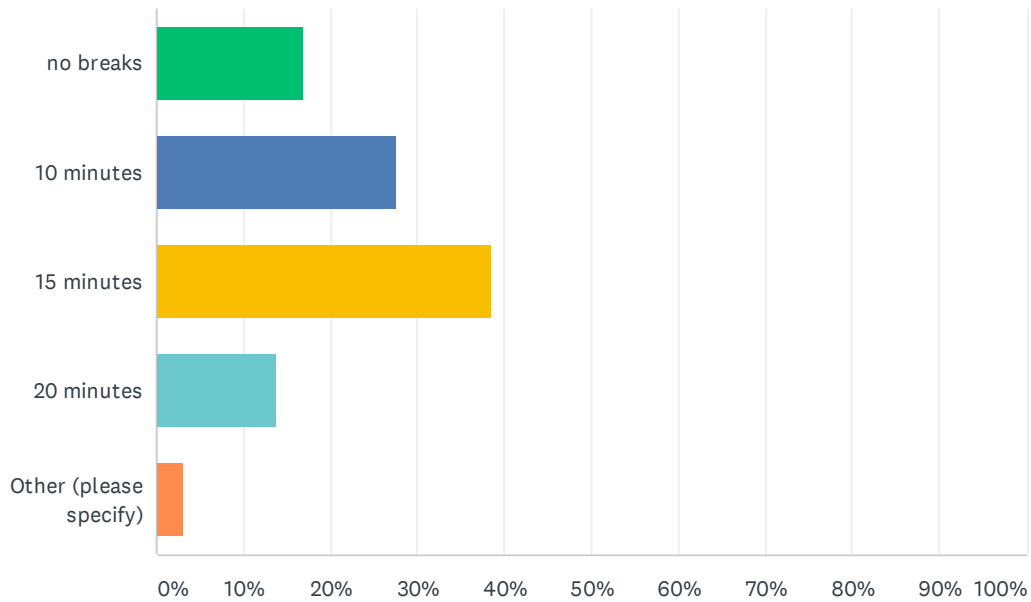

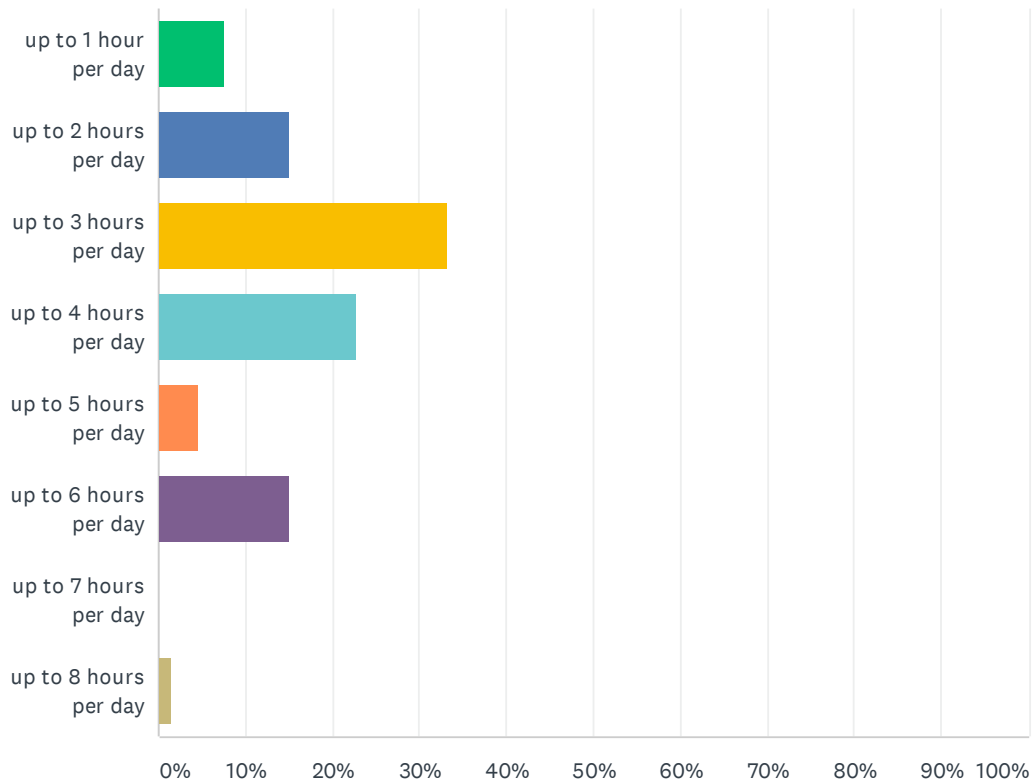

Q10 In case ICANN68 is being held as a virtual meeting, how many hours per day are you available or willing to participate?

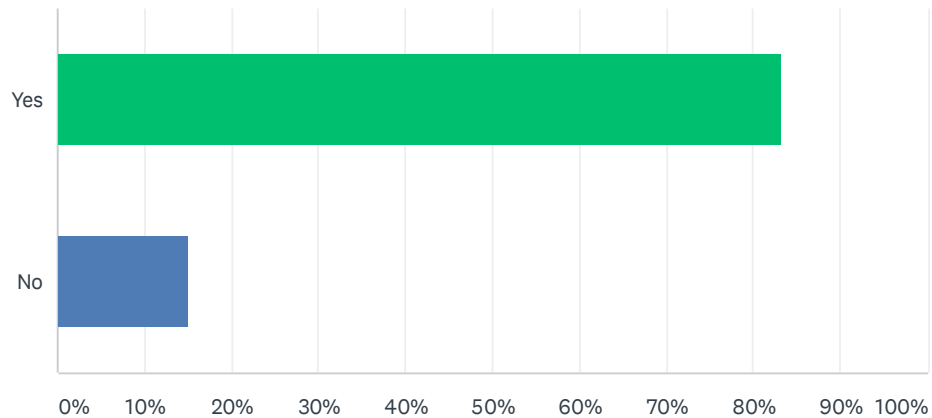

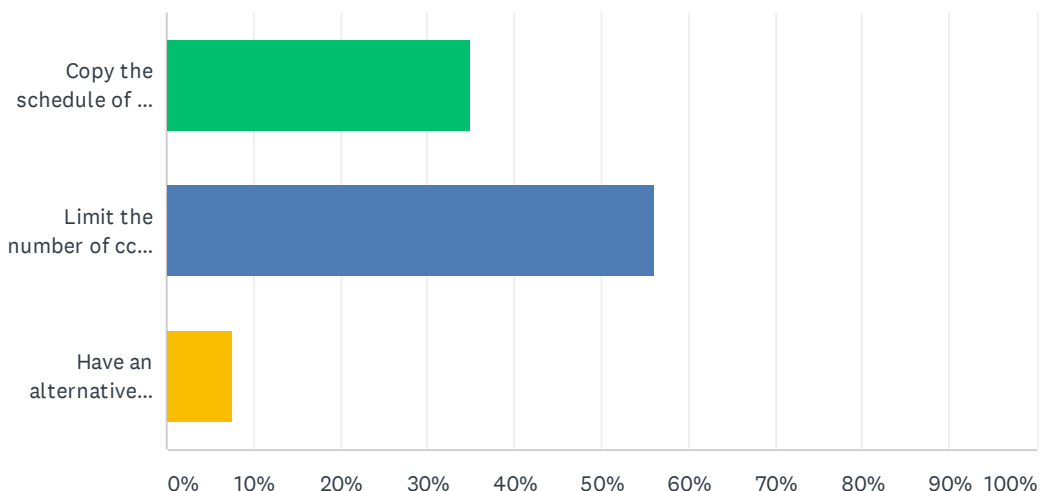
