# Recommendations meeting strategy review: survey feedback

1. Organise a ccNSO Members Meeting at every ICANN meeting
2. The Meeting Programme Working Group should explore the possibility to organise a 1-day ccNSO Members Meeting during the second ICANN meeting of the year.
3. Keep the ccNSO Members Meeting as a single stream, and do not organise parallel sessions.
4. When putting together the agenda for the ccNSO Members meeting, the Meeting Programme Working Group should keep in mind those priorities highlighted via the survey, namely:
  - a. developing relations between ccTLDs
  - b. providing updates by and to the ccTLD community

# Recommendations meeting strategy review: Additional recommendations

5. The Meeting Programme Working Group should attempt avoiding unnecessary overlap or duplications with regional organisations' meetings.
6. The ccNSO council should ensure that the joint sessions with other supporting organisations and advisory committees at public ICANN meetings are a valuable experience for all parties, in terms of their objectives and timing.
