Gap Analysis Request with Respect to Community Oversight of PTI Services

Dear Göran

I am writing to follow up on our earlier correspondence regarding the Gap Analysis Request with respect to Community Oversight of PTI Services (September 2018). The ccNSO Council would like to withdraw that request and proposes neither ICANN Org, nor the ccNSO takes any further action with respect to this request.

As you may recall, in September 2018, I wrote to you to follow-up on a specific recommendation to the ccNSO as included in the Final Report of the Customer Standing Committee Charter Review Team (June 2018). The Review Team recommended that the ccNSO Council should request a gap analysis to understand whether there are any strictly operational topics and issues which are dealt with by PTI whilst performing the IANA Naming Functions, that not clearly under the remit of the CSC or other SO, AC or a group such as RZERC.

During our conversation in Barcelona you asked for further clarification.

As a follow-up, the ccNSO Council has asked the person who originally suggested the gap analysis to provide the requested clarification but, despite several reminders, the clarification was not provided.

At its May 2020 meeting, the ccNSO Council decided not to take any further steps and withdraw the original request and asked me to inform you accordingly.
