Dear Ms. Cowley:

Please accept this correspondence as notice that Employ Media, pursuant to ICANN-approved [RSEP 2007002](#), will make two-character domain names available to potential registrants to acquire as their “companyname” (trade name) beginning on September 1, 2011, on first come, first serve basis through .JOBS accredited registrars.

For ease of reference, RSEP 2007002 states in pertinent part:

“Employ Media has stated that two-character names will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis through ICANN accredited registrars, and that it will distribute a press release internationally to provide adequate notice to potential registrants within the global community of employers (which may include governments as employer organizations) and notice to the ccNSO and GAC of the timeline for availability of two-character domain names in .JOBS.”
